### PERFORMANCE INVESTMENTS

#### What is my financial investment?

Each dancer performing in the Nutcracker will pay a \$65 Performance and Media Fee.

#### What is a Performance Fee and Media Fee?

The **Performance Fee** covers the extra expenses of staff during recital, stage lighting and props, costume alterations and cleaning, sound and light technicians and all of the extra costs that are associated with an amazing performance. The **Media Fee** provides each family access to download all photography that is taken during our live performance by our professional photographer Charlotte Gardunia. **Performance Fees and Media Fees** will be automatically debited to your account on file on **October 15 in the amount of \$65**. Once performance charges have been processed they are non-refundable.

#### What is included with my Performance Fee?

Everything that your dancer needs, except for shoes and a nude leotard, are included with this performance fee. Rentals for all accessories, props, costumes, and a pair of tights (yours to keep!) are included in your performance fee. Shoe requirements are the same as their weekly class shoes. Your Performance Fee also helps to cover necessary insurance costs associated with a professional production.

#### What is a Media Fee?

Our amazing photographer, Charlotte Gardunia, will be taking photos, before, during and after the performance. Following the performance she will send each family an email with the gallery and parents can download anything you want!

#### **Nutcracker Tickets**

All studios sell tickets to their performances to cover the cost of the venue and other expenses that come with producing a top-notch experience for children and their families. Tickets will be available through a ticketing service and range from 18-24 dollars. In order to be admitted to the recital, a ticket must be purchased. Everyone must have a ticket who is attending the show, the only exception are infants.
